

The report, “**Annual Percent Proficiency Changes in ELA by RSD Schools and Grade Levels on iLEAP and LEAP**” was developed to investigate the annual gains and losses in percent proficiency for English Language Arts (ELA) from 2007 to 2011. Percent proficiency refers to student performance on iLEAP or LEAP that is at the BASIC level or above. The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) also refers to this proficiency as scoring at “grade level.” This report is intended to be a reference source for those education stakeholders who need to investigate and analyze the validity of the claims of phenomenal achievement progress made by the Recovery School District (RSD).

Concerns about the validity of the achievement progress at some schools must be raised due to the recent revelations in the press about cheating scandals on standardized test that have occurred in a number of cities. Unfortunately, the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) does not provide official guidelines to school districts as to what constitutes unusual gains or losses on standardized tests. Given this lack of guidance and previous exploratory data analyses on gains and losses by this author, ROR’s position is that annual increases or decreases in excess of +/- 20 points should be flagged as questionable and further investigated by the RSD or LDOE. However, since this report is basically designed as a reference tool, the reader must make the judgment call on what constitutes an excessive gain or loss.
